

ELECTION DAY NOTICE

Here's a few things to think about.....



Have your ID!! In Wisconsin, we have voter ID. Don't agree with that? Do NOT take it out on the election workers. They didn't make the law, they only uphold it. Say your name out loud, let the inspector find your name, then say your address. We will not memorize your address while we're looking for your name. I mean we're good, but not THAT good.



Like a certain candidate? Great! But **DO NOT** wear any campaign items (shirts, hats, buttons) to your polling location. If you do, you will be asked to take items back to your vehicle or turn your shirt inside out in the bathroom, whatever. It's called electioneering and it's illegal.



Did you vote absentee? Once you begin the process of voting absentee, you need to complete that process. Do not bring your ballot in, thinking you can feed it into the ballot box. That's not how it works! If you no longer want to vote absentee, contact your clerk. Absentee voting is an added cost to your community so if you don't need to vote absentee, go in to vote on Election Day.



There is an option for write-in candidates. If you have a legitimate candidate you would like to win, by all means write that name down. But you need to know only registered write-ins are counted. And as for voting for Sponge Bob or your dog or Mickey Mouse, **DON'T DO IT!!!!** Although we don't need to count them, we do need to find those votes to see if they are legitimate or not. This is VERY time consuming, and, in the end, no one sees these SILLY write-ins except for the election workers. YOU'VE just made our job harder and WASTED a lot of our time. We don't think you're funny!! At all!!



Always bring your patience with you on Election Day! You might happen to come at a busy time or an inspector needs a break (we are allowed bathroom breaks!). We try to get you through the process as quickly as possible. Honestly, if you roll your eyes at me, I'll go slower.



So, get out and vote!!! It's your right!!
